Enjoy recreational play through arts and crafts, games, songs, story time, music, science, nature and much more.

Bring a snack and water bottle each day. All-day children should bring sack lunches each day. All supplies, T-shirts and instruction are included in the program. Parent handbook will be sent one week prior to the program.

Occasional optional swim trips may occur to Oak Point Pool or the Eden Prairie Community Center. Parents are notified of pool trip options in advance. Playground programs are held rain or shine, but for the most up-to-date information parents are encouraged to call the **recreation information line at 952-949-8449**.

Experienced staff is first-aid and CPR trained. Youth are separated by age and involved in their own activities and games. If parents feel their child is capable and willing to join an older group, arrangements can be made.

The playground program is held at five of Eden Prairie's finest parks: Crestwood, Homeward Hills, Prairie View, Edendale and Miller Parks.

Playground camps are held Monday through Friday in one-week sessions. Half-day and full-day options are available.
